




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Digital Workplace with Microsoft – what does that mean?

The Digital Workplace is strongly associated with the idea of a decentralized workplace. Until last year, whether and how to implement this concept was often an individual company decision. The COVID-19 pandemic has made it vital. Working from home has become standard and unavoidable in many companies.

Microsoft 365 offers a wide range of tools that support collaboration

in the context of the Digital Workplace and raise it to a future-oriented level. In accordance with the "pareto" principle - roughly 80% of outcomes come from 20% of causes - the majority of work still has to be done after setting up a modern Digital Workplace. Processes must be



optimized on many levels. Unfortunately, details are often overlooked.



What often gets forgotten when switching to a Digital Workplace with Microsoft

Microsoft 365 provides the foundation for a successful enterprise Digital Workplace, but without extra effort its potential remains untapped in terms of productivity and collaboration.

Common pitfalls: Knowledge sharing and template delivery are inefficient. Time-consuming tasks like formatting and searching for documents affect the efficiency of the entire company. User-friendliness falls by the wayside and there is a lack of connectivity to existing CMS systems.

To help you on this journey, we would like to highlight 3 issues that should be addressed: data protection, performance, and collaboration.



Data protection as a risk and a necessity

Data protection has increasingly become a focus of the office landscape. This development extends to the Digital Workplace and presents those responsible with new challenges. Particularly in the home office, employees must be aware of the importance of data protection to protect personal and company-internal data. These 6 aspects should be taken into account when protecting data in a decentralized workplace.



1. Screen lock: Employees must lock their screen when leaving their workspace so that third parties cannot view or access the device.



2. Professional conversations: Telephone calls and video conferences with data protection-relevant content must not be audible to third parties. In particular, employees should avoid outdoor areas such as balconies, terraces, gardens, or open windows. They should also be aware of strangers in their homes.





3. Choice of the workplace: There are several things to consider here. Third parties must not be able to see the workspace and the screen during working hours. The screen should not face a door or window, for example. If this is not possible, special privacy films offer an alternative. Also, the workspace must be protected outside working hours. If possible, the workroom should be locked. Alternatively, at least all paper documents should be locked in a cabinet or similar and the computer secured with a password or other authentication protection.



4. Work devices: Employees should be equipped with purely business-related end devices in order to avoid mixing private and business data and to increase security. Although it is possible to use private devices in the home office, employees must not be required to do so. In any case, the connection to the company network should be made via an encrypted VPN connection. End-to-end encryption is also a good idea for communication, and regular security updates must be installed on the devices.



5. Technical environment: With regard to security, employees must be made aware of the use of private USB sticks and WiFi networks. Private USB sticks should be avoided; a strong WiFi password is mandatory.





6. Data backup: Data must also be backed up regularly. You should plan and implement a data backup strategy. In on-premises data centers, this means encrypted data storage. Nowadays data backup often happens in a cloud system. Particular attention must be paid to a secure connection to the cloud, strong passwords (and possibly two-factor authentication), and the ability to delete data after someone leaves the company. Furthermore, all data and drives containing company or personal data should be encrypted to guarantee the security of the data even if the device is stolen.

When it comes to data protection, there is a lot to keep in mind. People are often not sufficiently aware of the risks involved in handling data. Awareness, education, and appropriate technical precautions are important to ensure data protection and data security.



Productivity and performance

Change always means getting used to something new. This is particularly true of the change from a traditional workplace to a Digital Workplace. As old work processes change, new processes take effect. When the work environment is decentralized, there is a risk that employee performance will deteriorate, at least temporarily. Here we show you how you can prevent this.

The infrastructure must be right

Probably the biggest problem for performance in a decentralized workplace is technical infrastructure. While the employer controls infrastructure in a traditional office building, the situation is different in a home office.

Even if adequate end devices are provided, the home Internet connection often proves to be a bottleneck. Video conferences falter, calls are interrupted, and data transfer is delayed. Unfortunately, there is no miracle cure - solutions are very individual and have to be adapted to individual cases. As a rule, wired Internet is more stable and faster than WiFi. If a direct connection to the router is not possible, a detour via the power line using DLAN can be an alternative. If WiFi is the only way to connect the end device to the Internet, a different placement of the router, a WLAN repeater or a change to a different frequency range can also help. If employees do not have company-provided devices at their workplace, suitable accessories should at least be provided. Everyone should be equipped with webcams and audio devices to avoid problems with video telephony. This ensures smooth collaboration even via digital communication channels.

CMS systems as a challenge

CMS systems such as DAM or PIM are often not integrated with MS Office. You and your team can only use the content with cumbersome workflows. In addition, there is no synchronization of data. This poses the risk of using outdated information.

Smooth migration with Software as a Service

In terms of performance, a Digital Workplace offers a huge advantage: The software is offered as Software as a Service (SaaS). This means that provisioning runs via the cloud and a simple web browser is all that is needed to access the programs. This saves many resources in setting up and maintaining the software and avoids a lengthy changeover process.

In the context of the home office, this also has the advantage that the local hardware requirements are very low; even older and weaker end devices can use SaaS solutions without any problems. The Microsoft 365 programs are analogous to the already familiar classics, which makes renewed familiarization obsolete.



Productivity is lost in MS Office

In our Office Study, conducted by Nielsen, we identified the biggest time wasters in Office. Around 30% of time is spent on formatting documents alone. Searching for content is another productivity enemy. You lose valuable time in MS Office, which means less time to pursue your actual tasks.

Problem: time-intensive presentation management

ABUS implemented Informatica's PIM system to manage several hundred products (with thousands of different items). Each product relevant for a PowerPoint presentation is created in a bilingual product portfolio with 8-16 slides each. 
